**Administrative Issues:**

We hired, outfitted and trained 2 new officers 1 Full-Time Durham and 1 Reserve David Mitchell.

New Taser devices were implemented department wide to replace the outdated and malfunctioning devices. (Quartermaster Log Updated)

While addressing the mobile reporting process, it was determined that previously issued wireless hotspots may have been the cause of constant disruptions. Newer Model devices were negotiated at no cost to the city and distributed to the officers.
