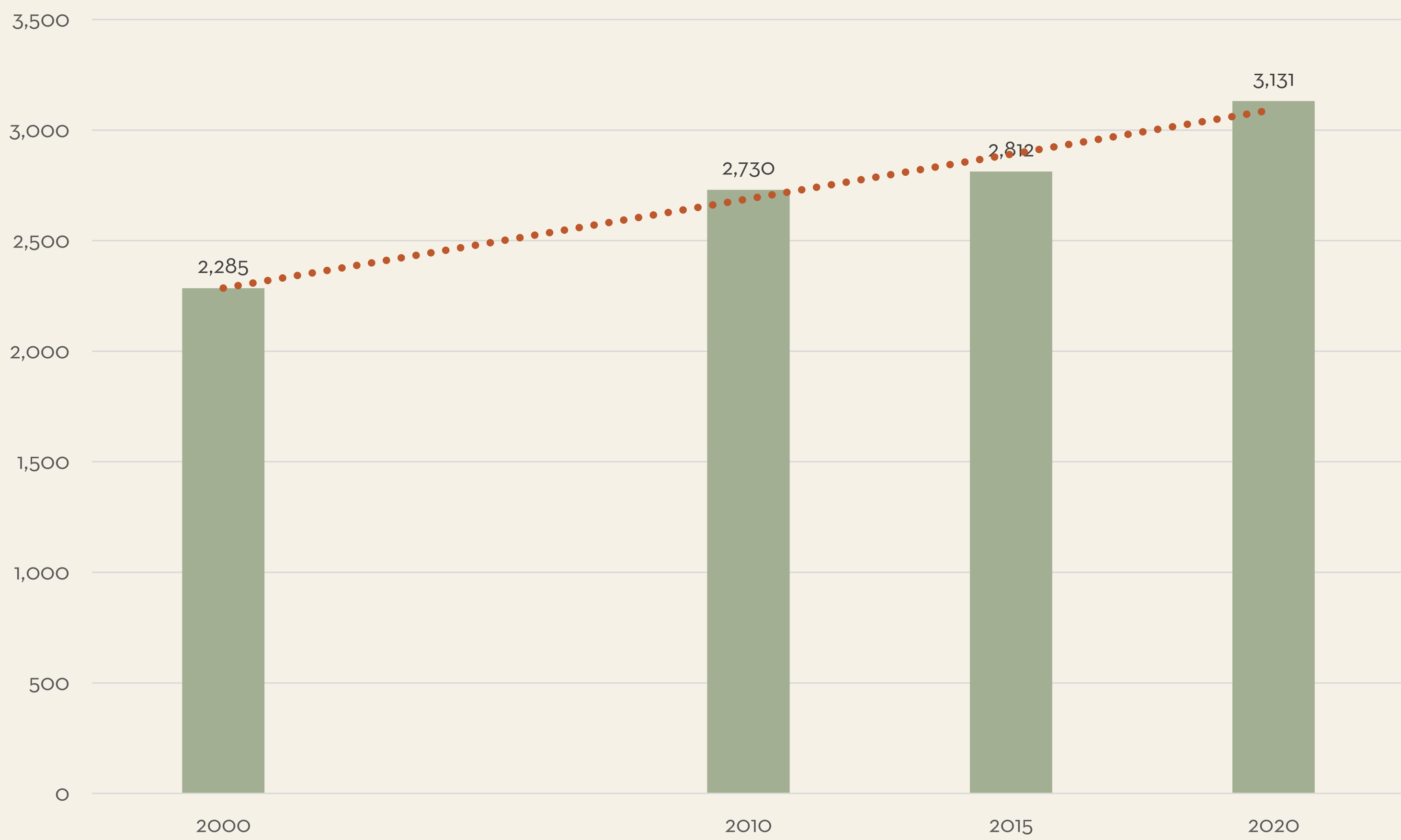


# POPULATION

Chattahoochee Hills Population

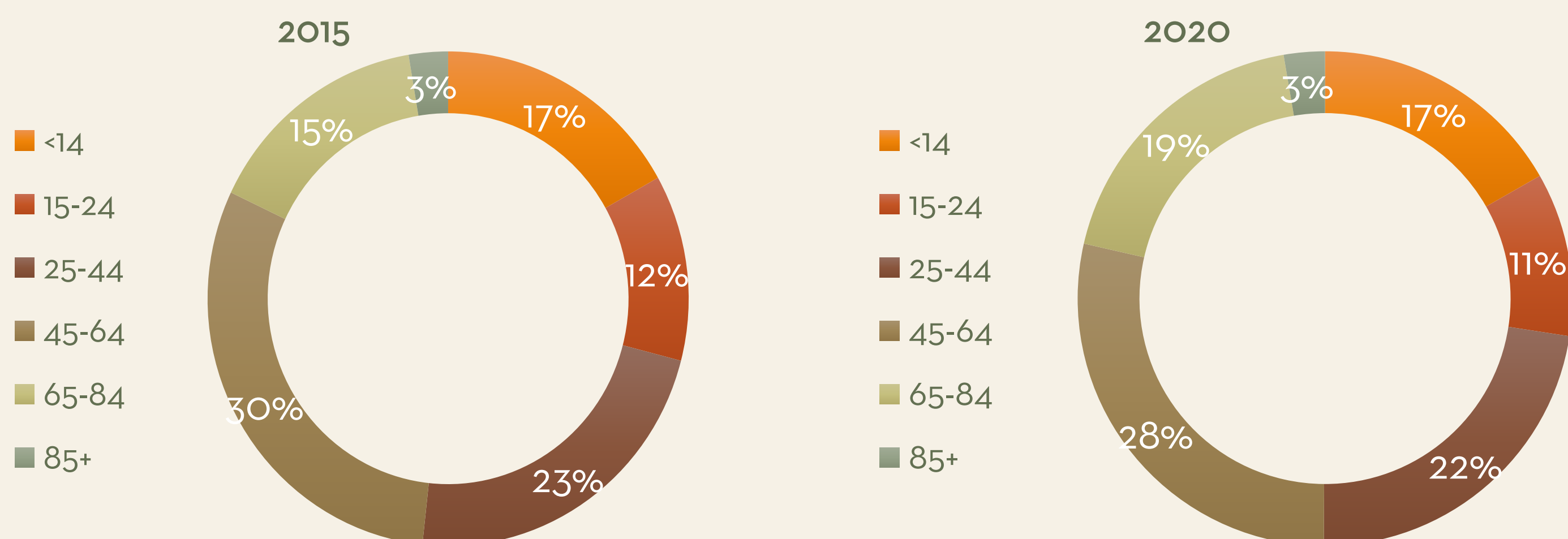
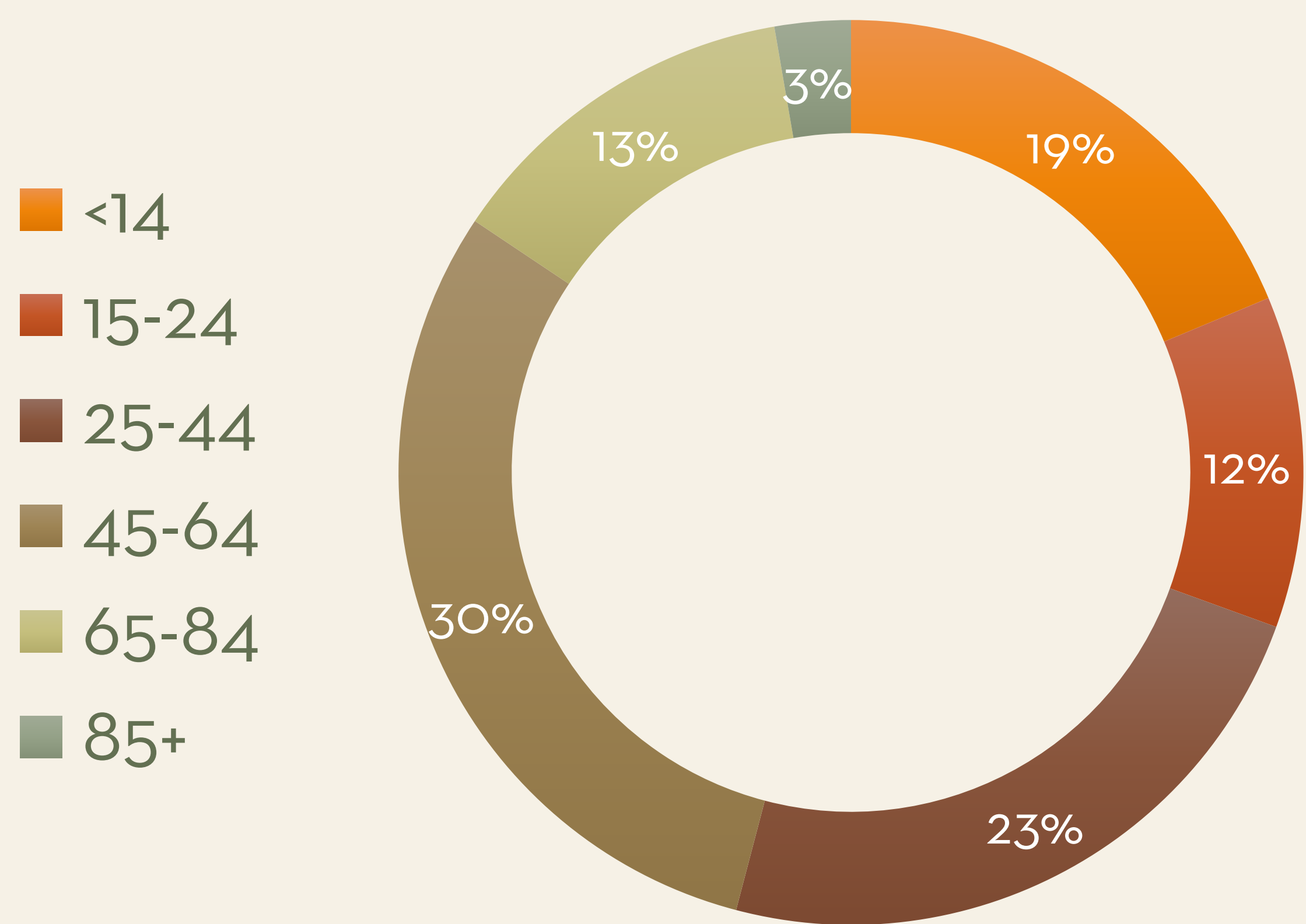


The city of Chattahoochee Hills was officially chartered in 2007. The first demographic data available for Chattahoochee Hills comes from 2010, at which point the population was 2,730. According to ESRI Business Analyst Projections, the population is expected to continue to grow.

## AGE

Young and middle aged adults (25-64) combine for 68% of the population. Children under 14 are expected to represent a smaller percentage of the population, while older adults aged 65-84 are expected to increase in proportion.

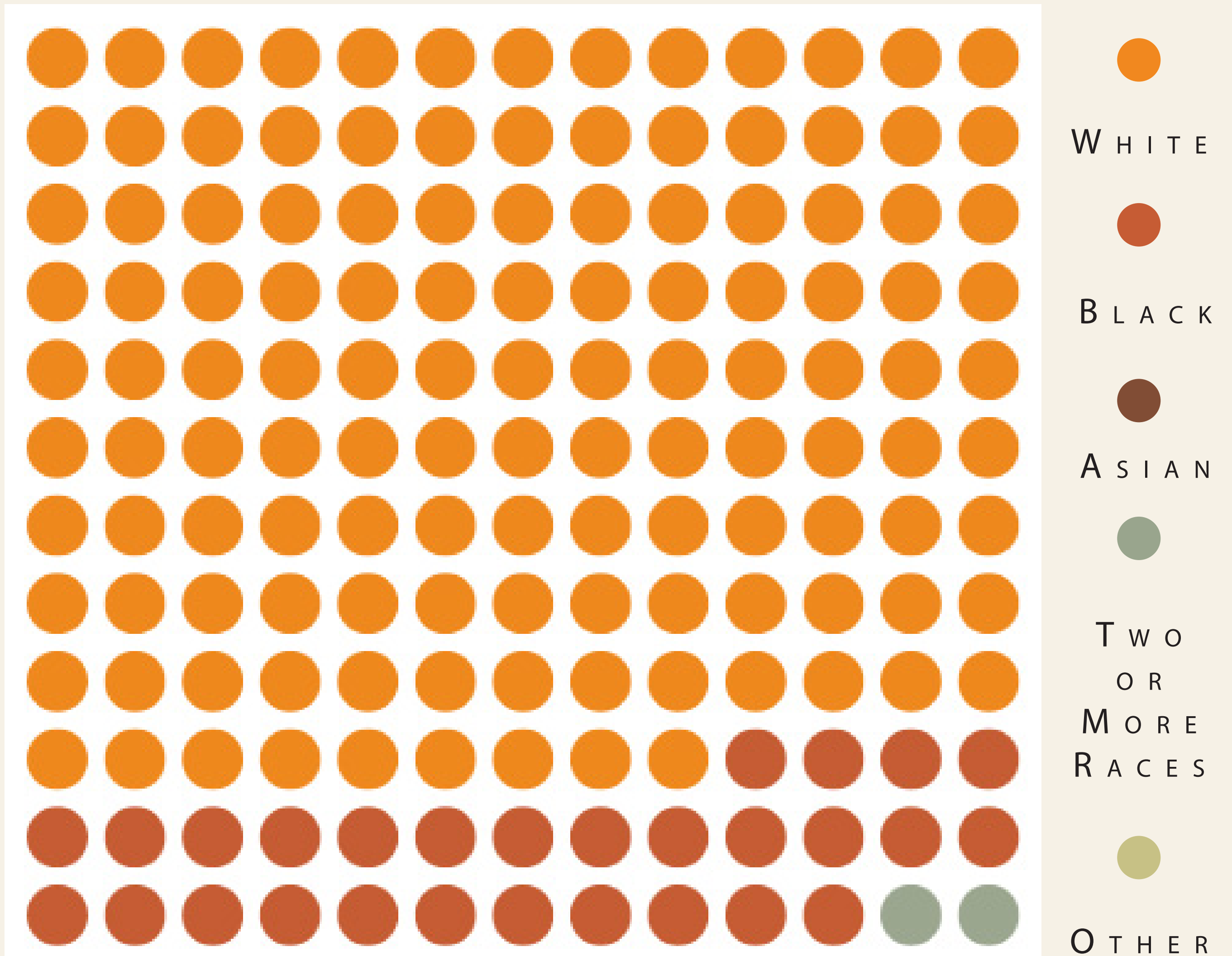

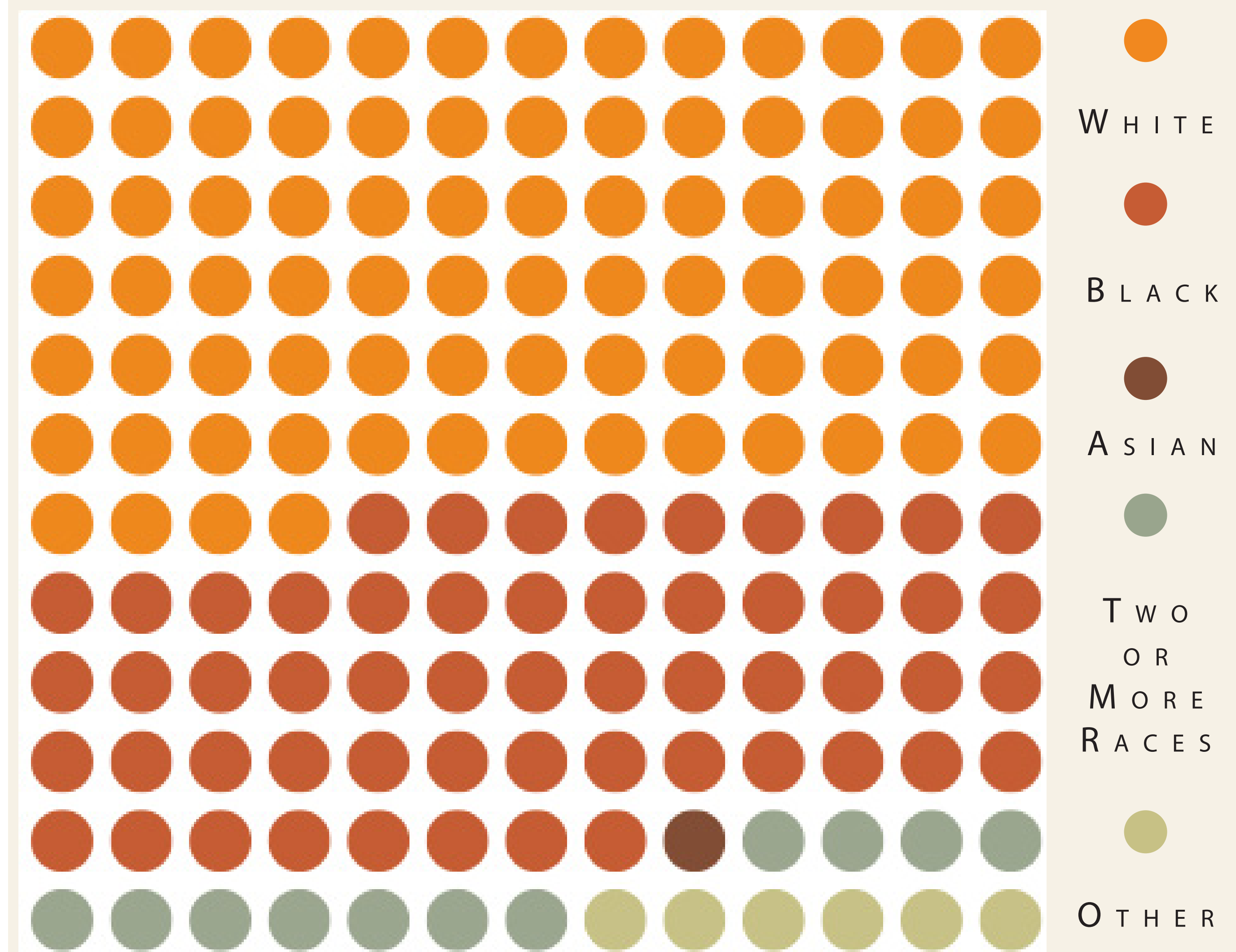
## RACE

### CITY BOUNDARY PRIOR TO ANNEXATION IN 2015

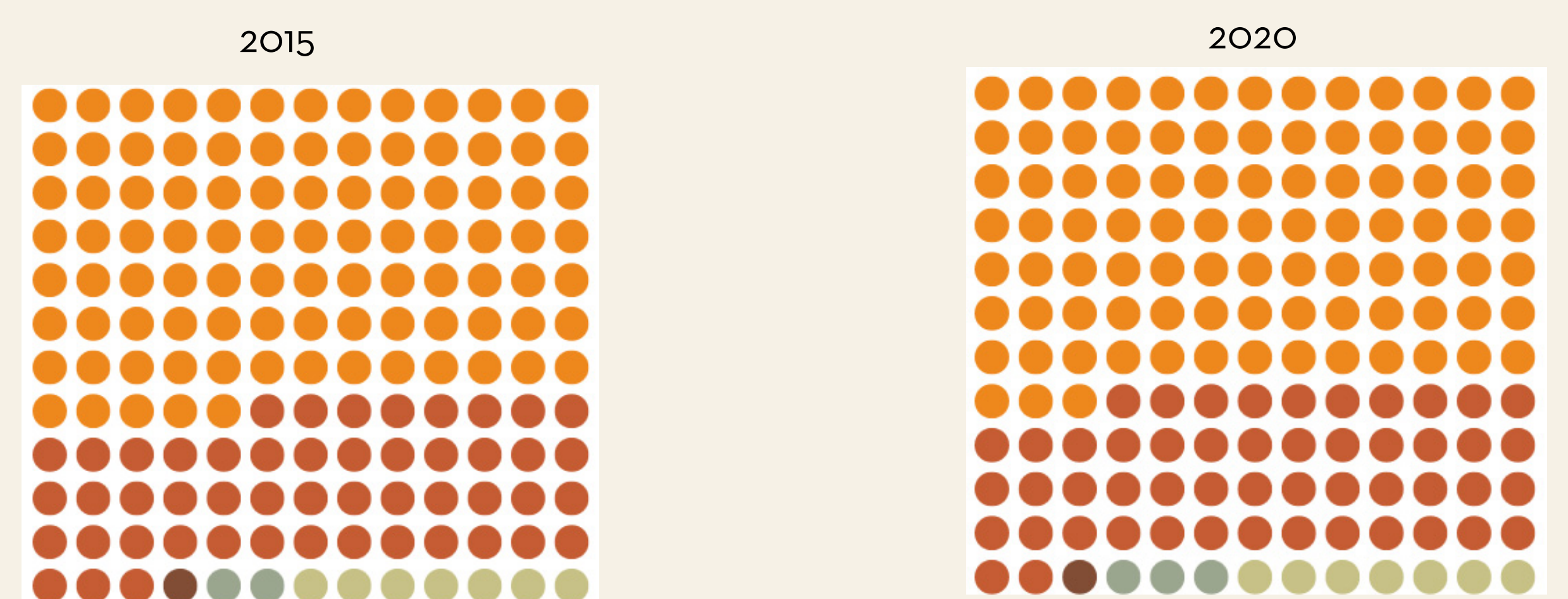


White people make up 68.6% of the racial distribution in Chattahoochee Hills as of 2010. Black people make up 28%, Asian people are .3% of the population, those of Hispanic origin are 5.6% of the population.

### CITY BOUNDARY AFTER ANNEXATION IN 2015



When the area of the 2015 annexation was factored into 2010 Census data, white people make up 55.9% of the racial distribution in Chattahoochee Hills. Black people make up 38.4%, Asian people are .4% of the population, those of Hispanic origin are 7.4% of the population.



The proportion of the population of white residents is expected to decrease gradually from 55.9% in 2010, to 55% in 2015 and 53.8% in 2020.
