194 citations were issued for the arraignment court in December, resulting in 153 cases (this included citations from October 2017 and part of November 2017). Of these defendants, we have 4 repeat offenders for the city.

13 FTA letters were sent out after November's court date resulting in 10 defendants, to date, settling their cases or rescheduling their court date.

Shannon Stroup, our court clerk attended training for our new TRIP program. The TRIP or Tax Refund Interception Program, will help assist in seizing Georgia Department of Revenue refunds of defendants that have failed to meet the payment structure of our Probation resulting from unpaid violations within our city.

December's court date is December 5, 2017 at 9:00 am for arraignments. The next scheduled court date is January 9, 2018 at 9:00AM for arraignments and 1:00PM for trials. 76 cases of the December's court calendar are bond forfeitures.
