Investigations:

The department's Criminal Investigations Division received reports of the following offenses during the month of April.

- Death Investigation (prelim autopsy findings indicate cause of death to be chronic alcoholism) - daughter of deceased reported no contact with her mother.
- Statutory Rape/Child Molestation (active investigation, offender is a relative of the victim and is identified - warrants are pending)
- Harassing Communications - on going investigation, warrants pending
- Identity Fraud – After a subject was notified of his information had been used in a traffic stop, subject known to him was revealed as the offender. Warrants obtained.
- Animal Abandonment - Public works employee witnessed a man dump a cat on Porter Terry Road
