



# Getting Vaccinated ...

## WHO / WHEN ..... There is a plan

Everyone should get vaccinated against COVID.

The Georgia Department of Public Health has created the following plan for vaccinating everyone according to “priority” groupings:

- PHASE 1A (JANUARY 2021)**
  - Healthcare personnel and long-term care facility (LTCF)
  - Adults 65 and older
  - Paid/Unpaid people serving in healthcare settings who have the potential for direct/indirect exposure including staff in clinical settings (e.g. nurses, physicians, EMS, laboratory etc.)
  - Long-term care facilities (LTCF) staff and residents
  - First Responders (fire, police, sheriff, 9-1-1 personnel, etc.)
- PHASE 1B (JANUARY 2021)**
  - People who play a key role in keeping essential functions of society running, including:
  - Critical workforce employees (e.g., educational faculty/staff, court employees, nuclear power plant employees, air traffic controllers, food processing, grocery workers, transportation, etc.)
- PHASE 1C (FEBRUARY 2021)**
  - Adults under 65 with comorbidities
- PHASE 2 (FEBRUARY 2021)**
  - Individuals in homeless shelters
  - Individuals in congregate settings (e.g. homeless shelters, dormitories, group homes)
  - Individuals in jails, prisons, detention centers
  - Other people living in congregate settings
  - All adults (41 – 64)
- PHASE 3 (FEBRUARY, MARCH 2021)**
  - Workers in industries important to the functioning of society and at moderate risk of exposure as listed in executive orders (e.g. hairstylists, barbers, restaurants, etc.)
  - Young adults (16-39)
- PHASE 4 (MARCH 2021)**
  - All other persons residing in Georgia for whom the vaccine is recommended
  - Children once the vaccine is approved for pediatric use.

## HOW ..... Register first

Pre-registration **MUST** occur to receive the vaccination. Persons arriving at vaccination sites without pre-registering cannot be vaccinated.

## HOW . . . . . Be persistent

Citizens of Chattahoochee Hills have several options for receiving the vaccination with others coming available almost weekly.

All vaccination sites are presently requiring pre-registration before arrival.
